From October 15th, 2008

- 10/28 was picture retake. 10/29 and 10/30 had students come and visit from area grade schools.
- Discussed Mr. Lloyd’s AP US History class as dual credit with Thomas More. Can take AP class and pay fee to get college credit if take a test and get a certain score. Have to take all 3 trimesters and take test.
- Discussed March for Life. Will leave Wed. January 21st and arrive Thursday am to go to Youth rally, mass, and march. They will then check in to hotel, eat, and sight-see. Only miss 2 days of school. Will rotate sight-seeing spots each year but will see Cathedral every year. Cost is \$135 - \$50 due 10/22 \$50 due 11/19 and \$35 due 12/7. So far have 131 permission slips turned in. Students may need some extra spending money but price will include bus, hotel, and box meal. Hope to have 8-10 students/adult. More info to follow.
