Student Assistance

What: CSS & NCC student assistance is designed to help students who are having difficulty performing academically due to personal problems or difficulties. The service provides assessment, counseling, support groups, educational materials and referrals for long term counseling or specialized treatment services. All information is confidential except for circumstances where the student or others may be in possible danger.

Who: The services are provided by Catholic Social Services in collaboration with Newport Central Catholic High School. **Your counselor is Amy Pittman, LISW, CCDCI**

When & Where: In - school hours are Tuesdays & Wednesdays 10:00-12:00 pm and Thursdays 12:00-2:00 pm.

How: A referral for student assistance can be made by students, Parents, faculty/staff or administration.

Students: Students may refer themselves or other students who they have a specific concern about by stopping in the office and completing a referral form or asking to speak with Mrs. Pittman

Parents: Parents can make a referral by calling the office (859) 292-3023 or stopping in to see Mrs. Pittman in person.

Faculty/Staff/Administration: Faculty, staff and administration can refer students by filling out the referral form or contacting Mrs. Pittman personally or by email.
