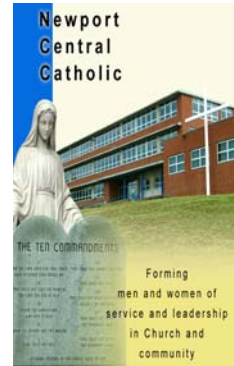

### Art

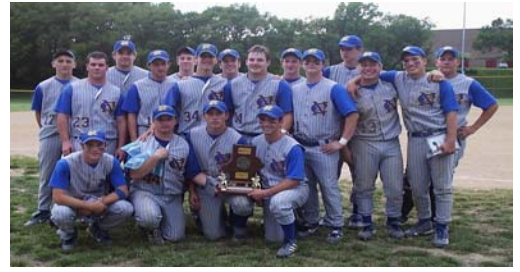
